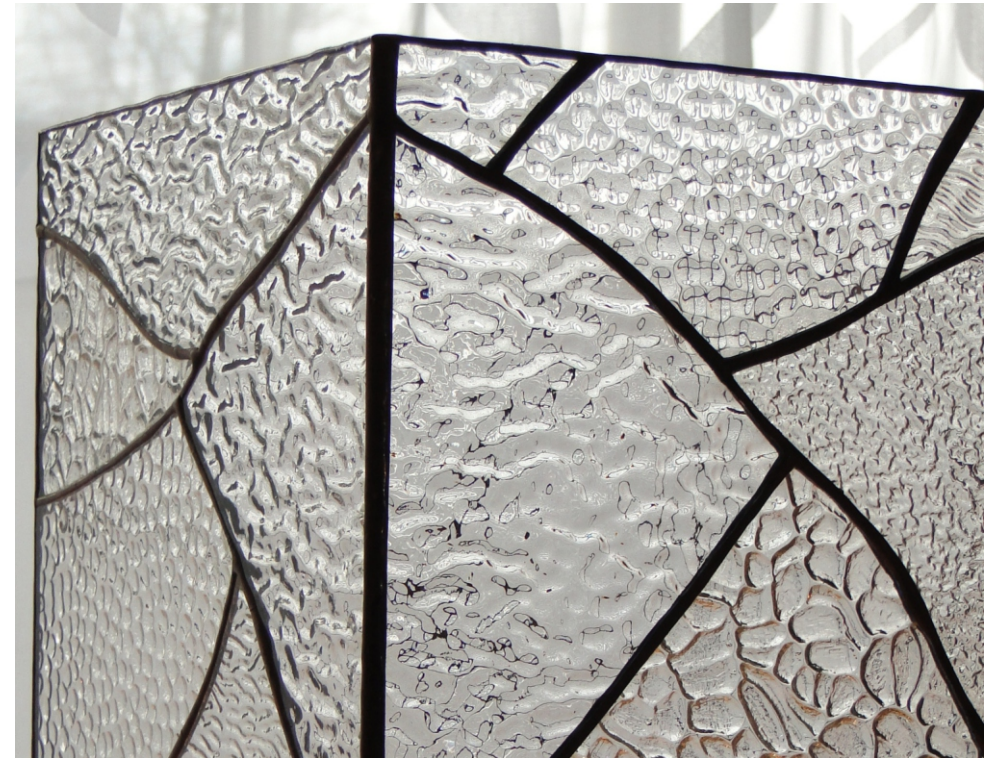

## Floor light “ textures “

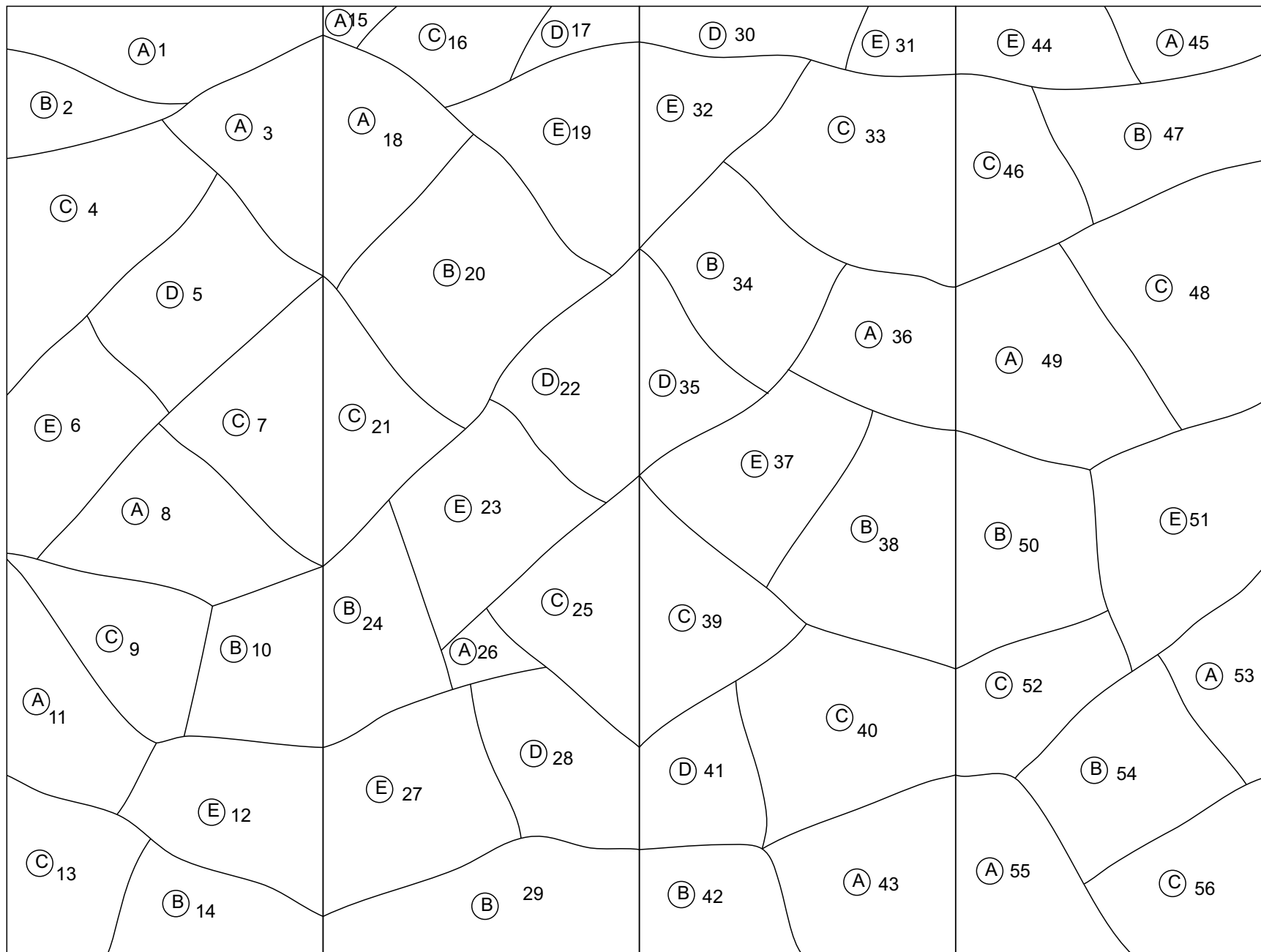


### Material for one floor light

Glass selection - the example shows:  
different clear glasses with texture .

Silver mirror for the bottom approx. 21x21cm ( 8" x 8" ).

Floor light “ textures “ size approx. 21 x 21 x 60 cm ( 8" x 8" x 24" )



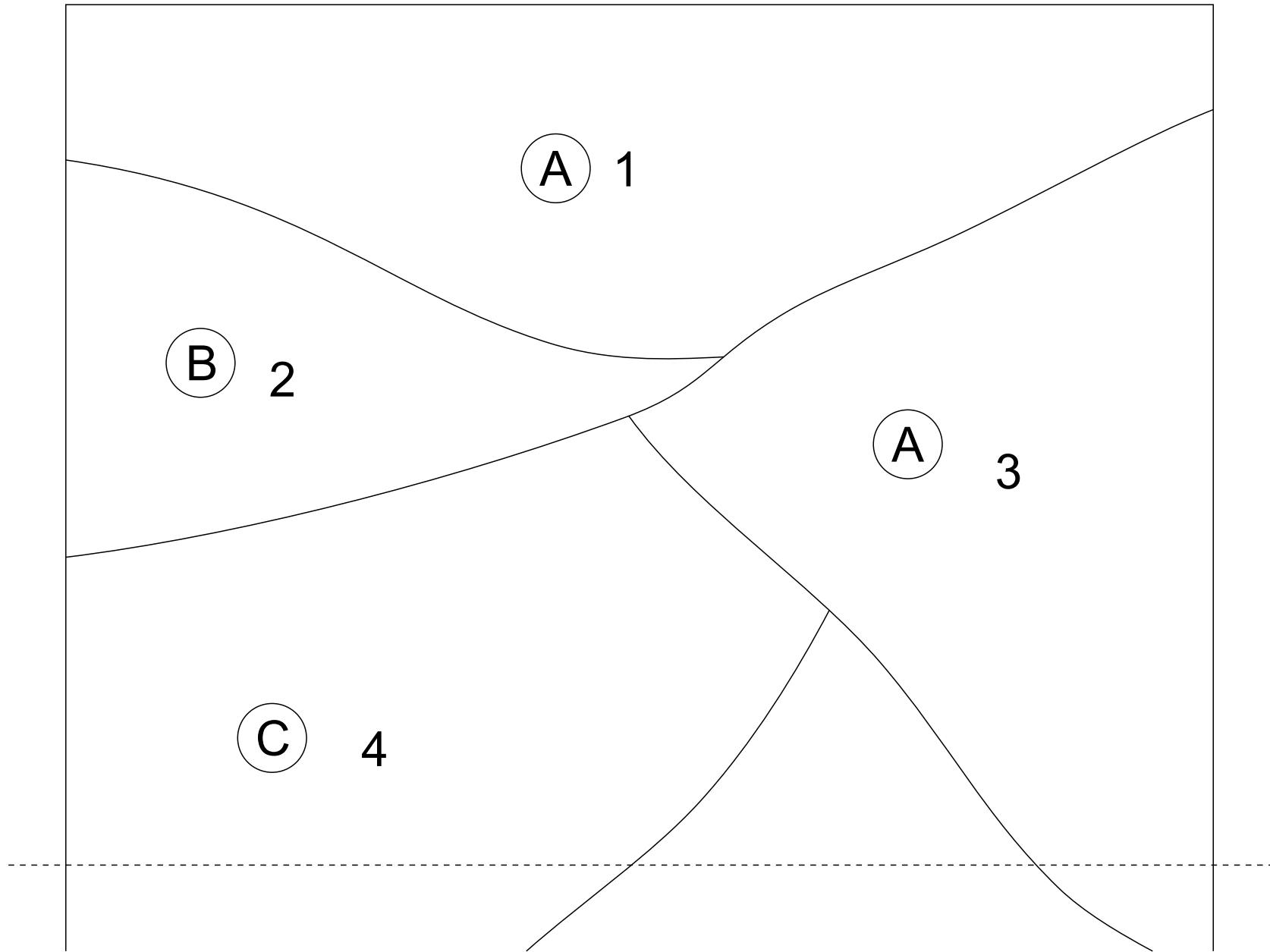
Glass selection as shown in the example:

- E: Wissmach 01 Moss

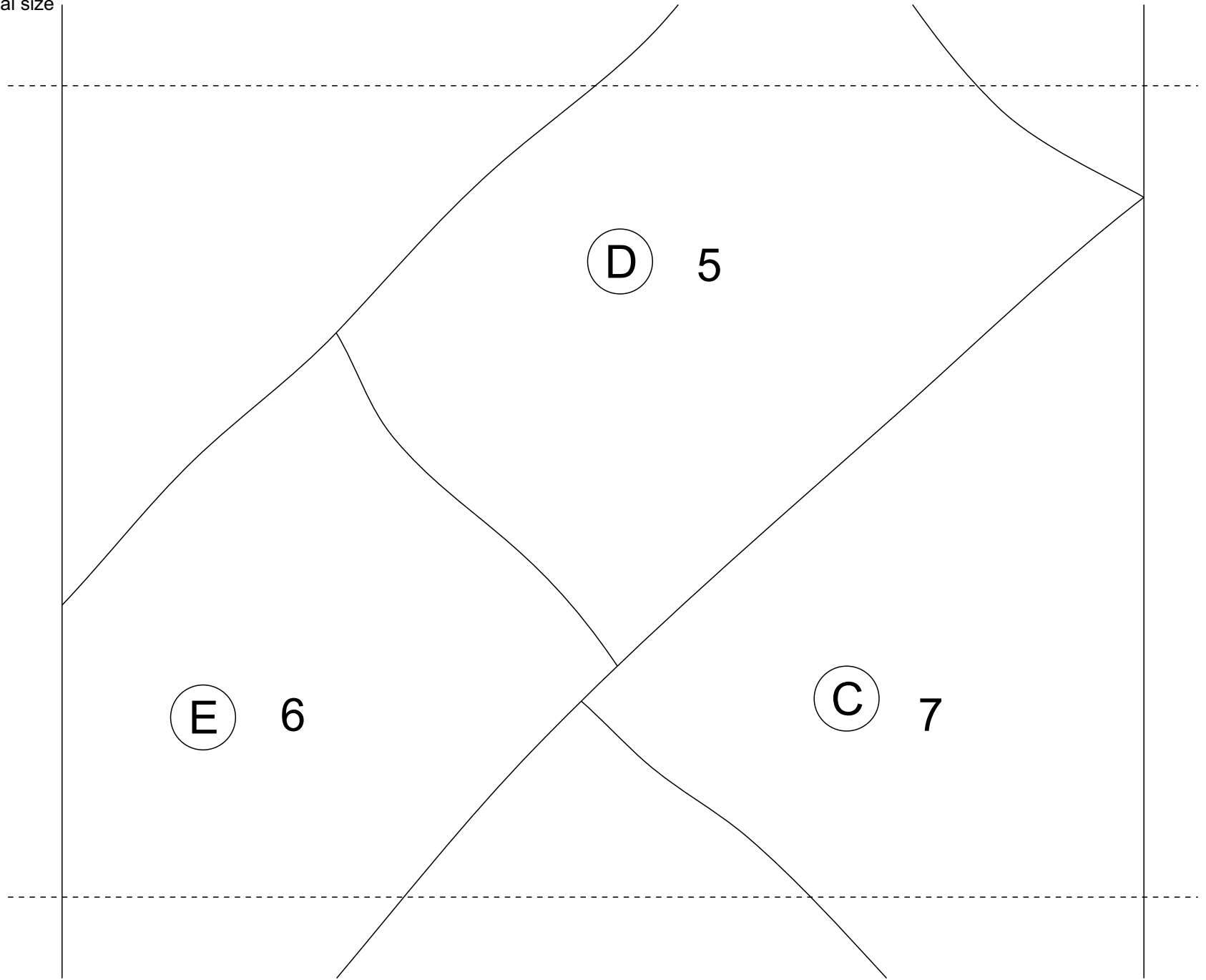

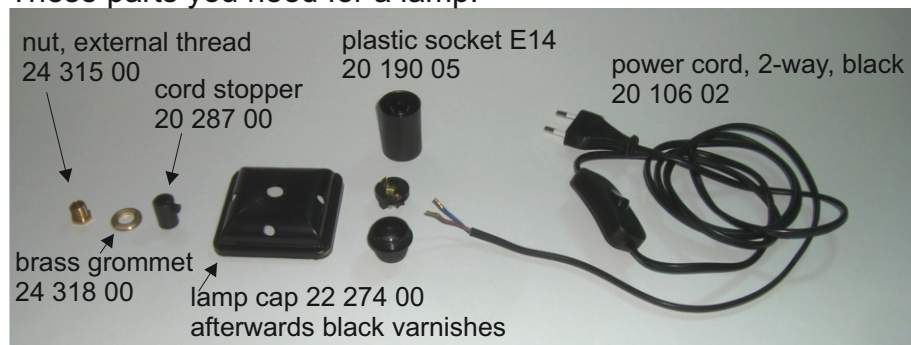




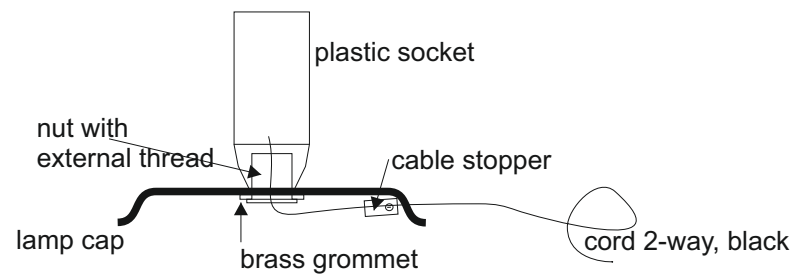
The view from top into the light.
