

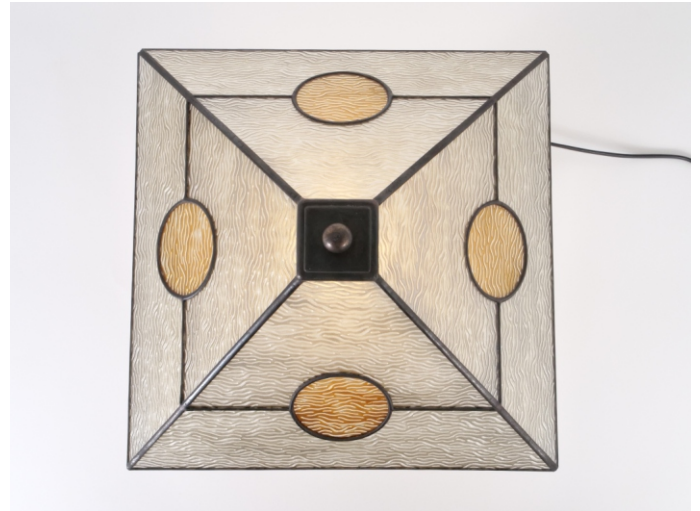

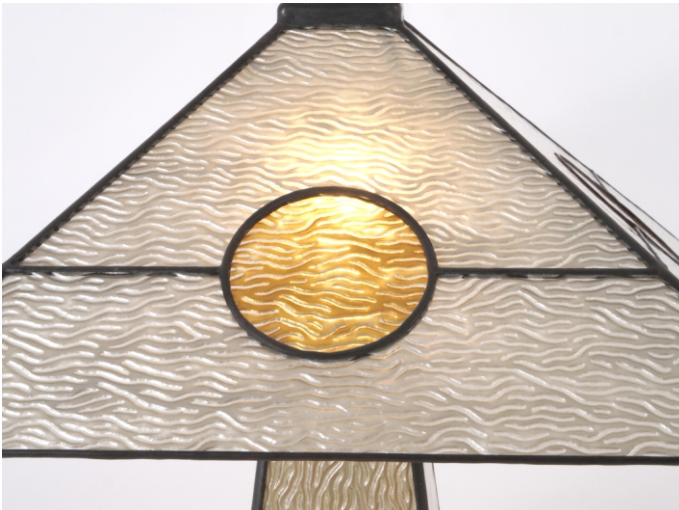




Gold and silver?
The design is of course universal and can also be made from "normal" colored glass.



After it's "burn-in" in the kitchen oven the silver-colored Pebeo Vitrea160 has a slight antique touch. Just right for the noble combination with gold.



I made the two examples from colorless textured glass (Wissmach Stream X01), after I painted the glass with glass paint Pebeo Vitrea160.



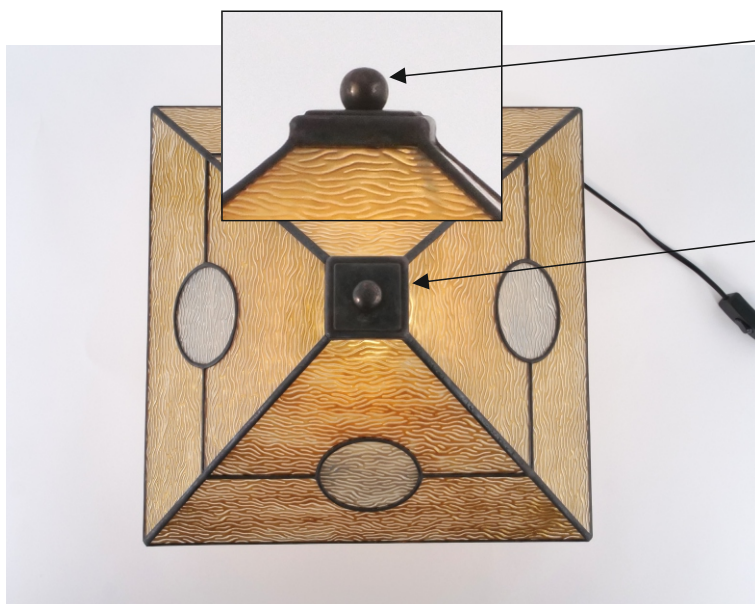
Even the base is not illuminated from the inside, a little light in the room is enough to let the colors shine. The gold comes wonderfully to the fore.



This design requires accurate work, but is also suitable for beginners, because only a few parts are connected. Good luck!



Important, do not forget the cable outlet. Simply grind a small hollow in the glass.
