

# Light Object - Olympic Torch

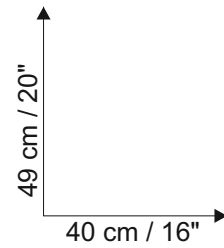

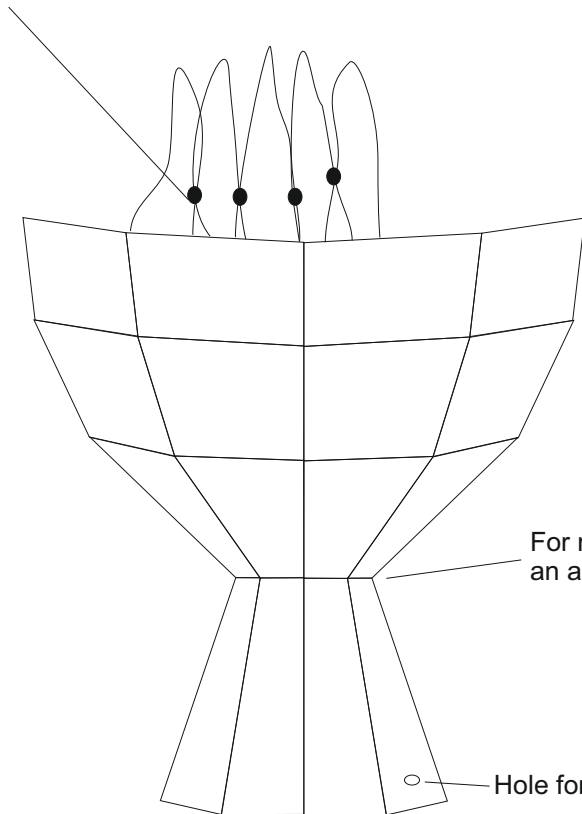
## Light object



Olympic torch

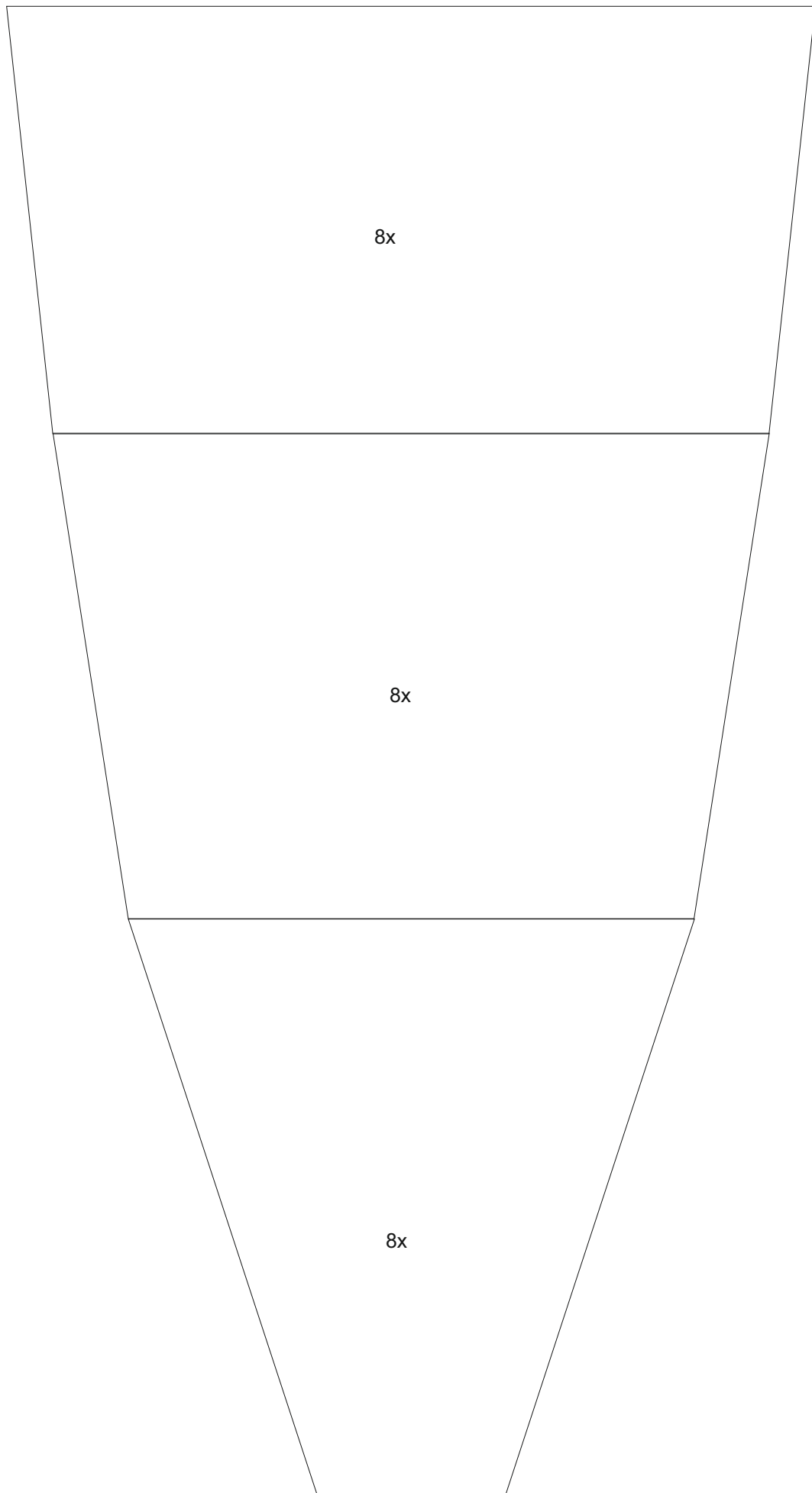


The individual flames are first soldered all around individually.  
Solder the flames then to the white glass.  
A sufficient stability gets the flame ring,  
when soldering the individual flames at certain points.

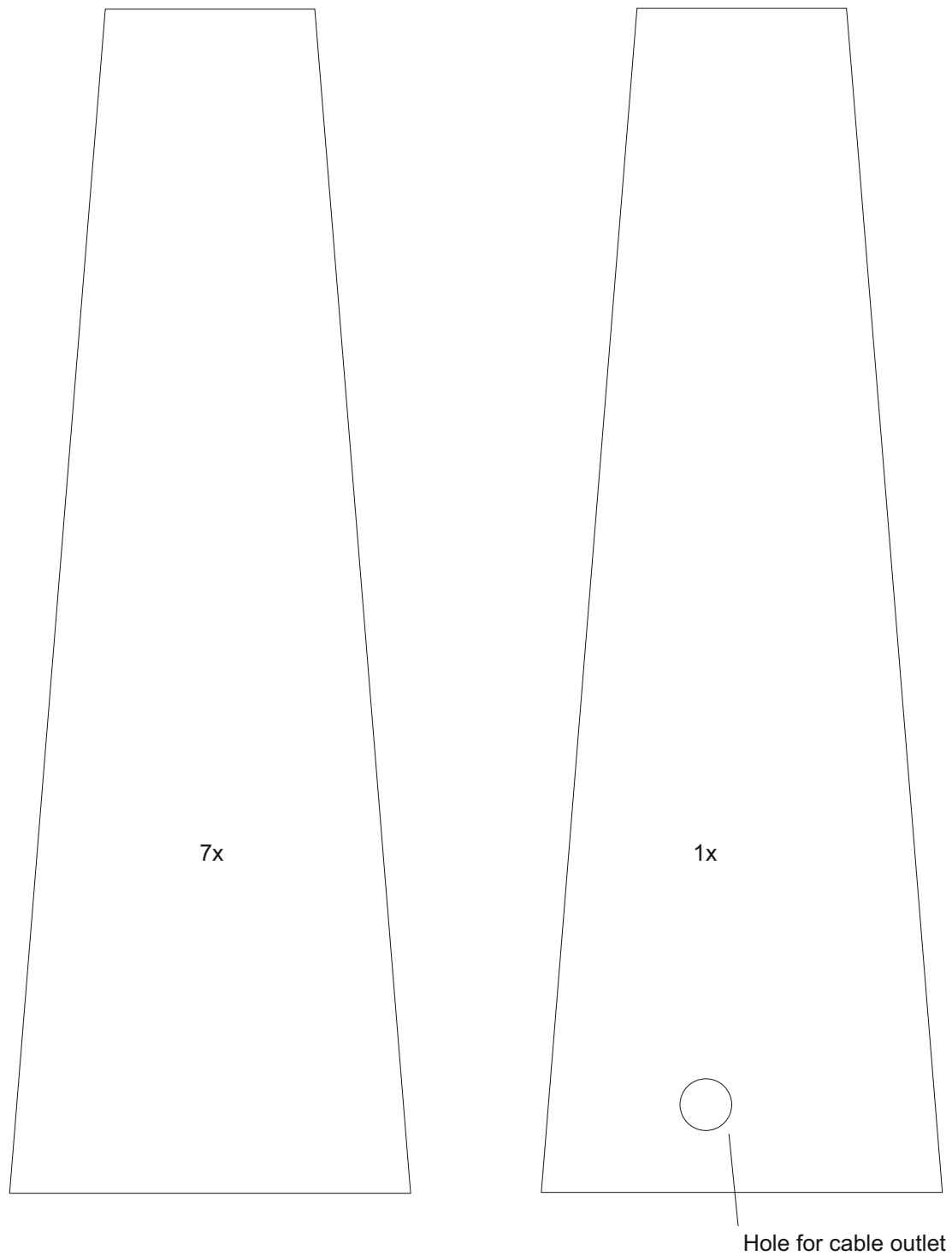


For reinforcement solder inside here  
an adjusted 4-way brass spider.

Hole for cable outlet



## Light object



The 40 flames you work freehand.  
The flames are about 20-30mm wide and 70-100mm in length.

List of materials as in this example:  
SCHOTT Opalika (flashed white glass 4mm) or Spectrum white 200s  
Uroboros flame red with some clear and white U60-25  
1 x 2415600 4-way brass spider
