“ Patchwork “

Patchwork is a millennia old technique, that ultimately makes senseful use of usable material remains. Used to be known in the field of textile processing. Today a variety of materials are processed in a patchwork design.

Nowadays the creative aspect is put in the foreground rather than the mere use of the leftovers

Still at the beginning of the here introduced designed glass pictures remains, a glass section from high-quality mottle glasses from Uroboros Glass in Portland, USA.

After the rough design of this study was found, I have filled the free areas with more specifically selected Uroboros mottle glasses.

Uroboros produces along with an extensive standard range, a product line named UNCAT (uncategorized = not categorized).

These specials are often a very interesting addition to the standard range, sometimes in quite unusual color combinations that are of course very well suitable for patchwork. Especially when the single pieces of glass, as pictured here, will be processed as larger pieces. An interesting gradient in each piece will become of great importance.
